RE: April Wine Concert September 17th Moving Forward

As of this morning, the Grey Eagle Event Centre and Tsuut'ina Nation have decided that we WILL be moving forward with the April Wine concert scheduled for Friday, September 17th. As per the AHS government mandate and in consultation with our health department, we will be instituting the following vaccination policy for this event:

All attendees must show proof of vaccination via their AHS vaccination paper record, a screen shot of their vaccination record or a verified vaccination record provided by Alberta Health Services online portal to gain entry into the Event Centre for the concert. Single vaccinated attendees ARE allowed entry to the Event Centre for the concert. Additionally, non-vaccinated attendees are allowed to enter provided they provide proof of a negative Covid 19 test within 72 hours to our security staff at the door.

Currently, for this concert we are also requiring all patrons and staff to wear a mask in all public spaces. However, patrons can remove their masks when they are consuming food and/or drinking in their seats.

Any attendee who has not received a vaccination or can't provide proof of a negative Covid 19 test within 72 hours is eligible for a full refund of their ticket purchased thru Ticketmaster or thru our Event Centre Box Office.

The Grey Eagle Event Centre and Tsuut'ina Nation have put these measures in place to protect the safety and well-being of our guests, staff and our Tsuut'ina community.
