Dear Valued Guests

Grey Eagle Event Centre welcomes the broader suite of restrictions announced by the Government of Alberta on Wednesday, September 15 to keep our community safe during these unprecedented times.

Grey Eagle Hotel will be fully participating in the Government of [Alberta Restrictions Exemption Program](#).

As per the AHS government mandate and in consultation with our health department, we will be instituting the following vaccination policies for these events:

- The Grey Eagle Event Centre and Tsuut'ina Nation have decided that we WILL be moving forward with all concerts scheduled to perform at the venue.
- All attendees must show proof of vaccination via their AHS vaccination paper record, a screenshot of their vaccination record or a verified vaccination record provided by the Alberta Health Services online portal to gain entry into the Event Centre for a concert.
- Single vaccinated attendees ARE allowed entry to the Event Centre for the concert with proof of their vaccination.
- Additionally, non-vaccinated attendees are allowed to enter provided they provide proof of a negative Covid 19 test within 72 hours to our security staff at the door.
- Currently, we are also requiring all patrons and staff to wear a mask in all public spaces.

The Grey Eagle Event Centre and Tsuut'ina Nation have put these measures in place to protect the safety and well-being of our guests, staff and our Tsuut'ina community.
