Dear Valued Guests

Grey Eagle Hotel welcomes the broader suite of restrictions announced by the Government of Alberta on Wednesday September 15 to keep our community safe during this serious 4th wave.

Grey Eagle Hotel will be fully participating in the Government of [Alberta Restrictions Exemption Program](#) Here's what you need to know as we welcome you here at Grey Eagle Hotel:

During your stay:

The Hotel operations including restaurants and events will proceed unchanged as planned at this time. We are happy we can continue to provide these exceptional experiences and services to you. We are also maintaining existing controls, including masking and health screening as well as adding some new ones:

Mandatory Vaccinations:

1. Beginning Monday September 20, 2021, Proof of vaccination status for those aged 12+ will be required to access our facilities such as pool, gym, restaurant and hotel event space.

- From Sept 20 to Oct 25: Anyone 12+ looking to access or use our resort facility and services must have received at least one dose of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine.
- Proof of a single dose is acceptable as long as the dose was given more than two weeks before time of entry to the resort facility.
- From Oct 25 onward: Anyone 12+ looking to access our resort facility and service must have received two doses of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccines.

Checking Vaccination Records:

Right now, there are several options people 12+ can use to prove vaccination status

- Paper: Immunization records received at immunization appointments OR Paper card printable from [MyHealth Records app](#)
- Digital: Records shown from [MyHealth Records app or website](#) OR a screenshot of immunization records received at immunization appointments

2. Grey Eagle Hotel will be implementing a mandatory vaccination policy that will apply to staff, volunteers and contractors.

- To protect the health and safety of our staff, guests and community, it is now required that all Grey Eagle Hotel employees, volunteers and contractors be fully vaccinated by no later than October 25, a date in alignment with the Government of Alberta's Restrictions Exemption Program.



COVID-19 Tests:

To enter spaces participating in the [Restrictions Exemption Program](#), people aged 12 and older can show proof of a negative test result.

Grey Eagle Hotel will only accept valid COVID-19 PCR or rapid tests completed within 72 hrs. and will be updated based on the length of stay. Tests must not be from Alberta Health Services or Alberta Precision Laboratories

Vaccine and Mask Exemptions:

In the specific settings or areas where a mask and proof of vaccination is required, anyone unable to wear a mask or have a vaccination due to a medical condition will require a medical exemption letter from an authorized health professional. Without the valid exemption letter, the management reserves the right to remove the guest from the property.
